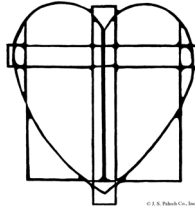

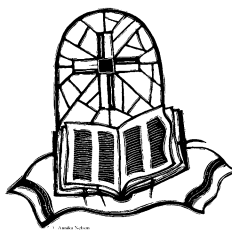


For those who need a contribution statement for the tax purposes please indicate it on the envelopes in this coming weeks so we can make that statement for you soon as we can.

Modlitwa do Matki Bożej Ostrobramskiej.

O Pani moja, Święta Maryjo! Twojej łasce, osobliwej strazy i miłosierdziu Twojemu dzisiaj i każdego dnia i w godzinie śmierci mojej dusze i ciało moje polecam; wszystkie nadzieje i pociechy moje, wszystkie uciski i dolegliwości, życie i koniec życia mojego Tobie poruczam, aby przez zasługi Twoje wszystkie uczynki moje były sprawowane i rządzone według Twojej i Syna Twego woli. Amen

Gratulacje i Życzenia Bożego Błogosławieństwa dla Biskupa Nominata Diecezji Rockville Centre Andrzeja Zglejszewskiego. Biskup Nominat pochodzi z Białegostoku.

Faustyna pisze, że w jakimkolwiek bylibyśmy stanie, zawsze powinniśmy się modlić: *Musi się modlić dusza czysta i piękna, bo inaczej utraciłaby swoją piękność; modlić się musi dusza dążąca do tej czystości, bo inaczej nie doszłaby do niej; modlić się musi dusza dopiero co nawrócona, bo inaczej upadłaby z powrotem; modlić się musi dusza grzeszna, pogrążona w grzechach, aby mogła powstać. I nie ma duszy, która by nie była obowiązana do modlitwy, bo wszelka łaska spływa przez modlitwę* (Dz. 146).
