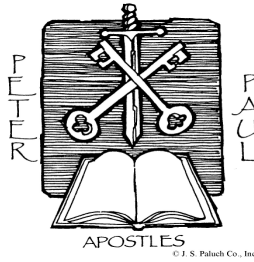

**AND PAUL** Today is something of a rarity: the celebration of a saint's day that replaces the Sunday liturgy. Only a handful of these days, given the official rank of "solemnity," are considered so foundational and primal to the mission of the Church that they can interrupt the Sunday sequence. And so it is with Peter



and Paul today. Each suffered a similar fate in the same city, Rome, during the persecution of the Emperor Nero, who probably ordered the destruction of many of the residential neighborhoods in service to his building projects, and when the homeless began to look for someone to blame for the fires, Nero targeted the Christians. Soon, Peter was crucified, upside down, on the Vatican hill. Excavations under the Vatican basilica have proven the authenticity of his burial place near the place of his death. Paul, a Roman citizen, was later granted a swifter execution by sword, and is remembered at a vast basilica on the city's outskirts. Peter and Paul were just about polar opposites. Peter rough and ready, Paul poetic and polished. Peter carried a burden of regret for his denials, Paul had his own issues with which he struggled. Peter leapt over barriers to go to the Gentiles, Paul strove with and surrendered to the same call. True, they spent very little time together in this life, but the same Spirit filled their hearts and by their witness changed the face of the earth.

**REGARDING THE ELEVATOR PROJECT THE PARISH COUNCIL ASKED FOR WHOLE PARISH TO MEET ON TUESDAY, JULY 8TH AT 7:30PM IN THE PARISH HALL.**

**PARISH NEWS** - the Project of the Elevator in the last parking lot side window would resolve our accessibility for the elderly and handicap to our Church and to the Parish Hall and the bathrooms. It would include the glass wall and doors on the back of the last benches of the church, update of the bathrooms, and additional water drainage hole on the parking lot. The price of the Elevator mechanism itself is \$ 30.000. The estimate price for all project is \$ 200.000. It would be all subject to bid done by companies that would be chosen by Parish Council to do the work, with the approval of the Diocese. The disign of the Elevator project is exposed on the back of the Church. The entrance to the elevator would be in the north wall in the place of the last window. Our Lady of Ostrabrama pray for us!

### **Znaczenie Modlitwy Pańskiej "Ojcie Nasz"**

Od dzieciństwa doskonale ją znamy jako "Ojcie nasz". Ale raczej nie bardzo uświadamiamy sobie i doceniamy doniosłe znaczenie jej wezwań błagalnych. Źródłem tej modlitwy są biblijne teksty: Mt 6, 7-15 i Łk 11,1-4. Jest ona podstawą wszystkich modlitw. Jezus podaje siedem prośb, które wskazują hierarchię wartości. Uczy, od czego zacząć, jak prosić i o co warto się modlić. Przy okazji wymienia główne warunki dobrej modlitwy: unikanie gadatliwości, przebaczenie bliźnim, docenienie wspólnoty, rezygnację z własnej woli. Jednak Jezus nie tylko uczy tekstu i formy nowej modlitwy. Przede wszystkim objawia, kim jest Bóg. I zachęca do przyjęcia właściwej postawy wobec Ojca w niebie. Modlitwa "Ojcie nasz" nie jest więc modlitwą łatwą. Jest to "głębokie wejście w doświadczenie Syna, który składa całkowity dar z siebie" (por. Mt 26, 39. 42). Historia liturgii podaje, że w pierwszych wiekach Modlitwa Pańska była objęta zasadą milczenia. Chrześcijanie nie przekazywali jej nikomu spoza swego grona. Bo "jak może mówić do Boga »Ojcie« ktoś, kto nie zjednoczył się z Jego Synem?". Cdn.
