

**FROM THE PARISH MEETING**

Regarding the project of church restoration and making it more handicap accessible, we have discussed the necessary steps to realize our goals, including:

- 1) Installing an elevator to access the church and its basement from the north side parking lot, placed outside the last window in the rear of the church with an entrance door installed to replace the window.
- 2) Restoring the restrooms to handicap accessible code, and securing a water connection from the Town of Southold.
- 3) Improving the drainage in the parking lot and making the access path to the elevator water/ice free.
- 4) Placing a glass wall in the rear of the church behind the last pews to minimize elevator noise and establish a crying room area for young children.

Initial cost estimates place the price of the entire project at \$200,000, with attainment of our stated goals limited to what our fundraising efforts permit. We would ask all parishoners to pledge what they can afford in the designated fundraising time period, with the possibility of extending the time period if additional time is needed. Contributions are totally voluntary, and no one should feel pressured except by the Lord Himself and Our Lady of Ostrabrama if they give you the faith to see the necessity of these improvements. To begin, we would send a letter to all 420 parish-registered households with a full explanation of the work to be done and requesting their financial pledge for same. Because we would have to secure permits from the Diocese of Rockville Centre and the Town of Southold to proceed, we will only start the project if we reach our fundraising goals. All improvements will be dedicated to Our Lady of Ostrabrama Church which marks its 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2019.
