OUR CHURCH RENOVATION PROJECT

Dear Parishioners and Guests, In 2019, Our Lady of Ostrabrama Church will mark its 100th anniversary. We would like to begin a construction project to ensure access into and use of the church and restrooms for all parishioners and visitors. Our plans include: **installation of an elevator** with a vestibule and, possibly, a glass enclosure; **renovations of the restrooms, making them handicap accessible; and repair of the drains in the church parking lot.** The elevator will provide entry into the church and into the church hall from the parking lot level. The estimated cost of this project is **\$200,000**. To guarantee its successful completion, the church is asking for your financial help.
