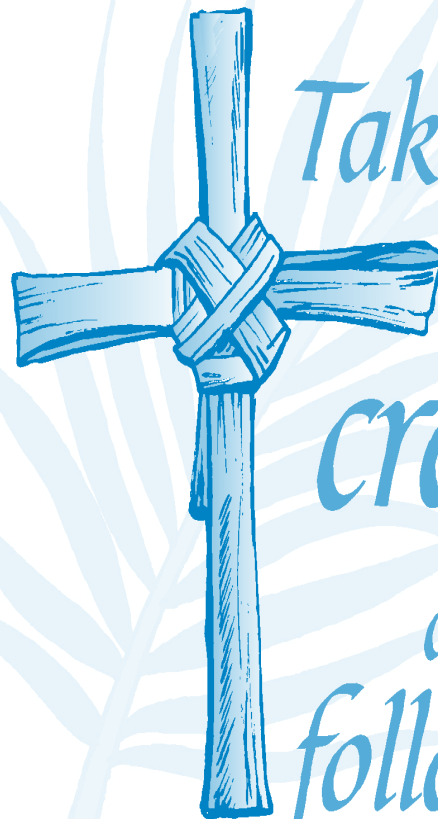

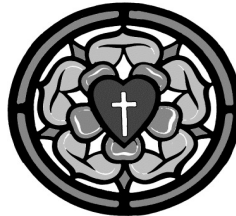

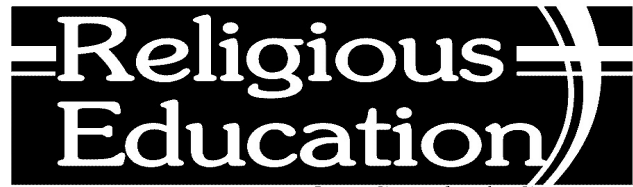

The registration fee is as follows: \$80 for one child; \$150 for two children; and \$200 for three or more children. Please register prior to the first day of class to allow us to prepare properly for the new year. The class schedules and registration form links you may find on Parish Website www.ourladyofostrabrama.com Classes will begin the week of September 22nd. The CCD program will follow the Cutchogue- Mattituck School District calendar. When classes are cancelled, your child's teacher will notify you by email.
