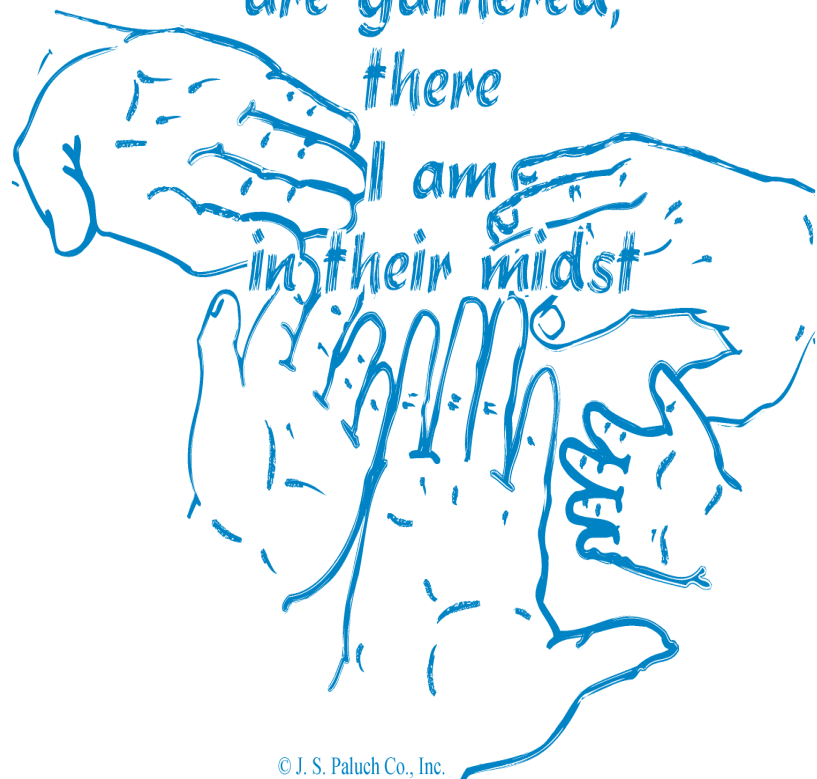
PARISH REGISTRATION: All families should be registered in the Parish. A census card may be obtained in the church entrance. If you are moving, please notify the Rectory.
