SAINT BERNADETTE AND OUR LADY OF LOURDES

(Continued from Bulletin of March 8th) Estrade recorded a conversation between the Chief of Police and Bernadette. During that meeting, M.Jacomet deliberately tried to confuse Bernadette to change her account of the apparitions. When that attempt failed, the Chief of Police released Bernadette to the custody of her father with an admonition that he take her home and guarantee that there would be no further disturbances. But the interior call which was urging her on was stronger than any earthly admonition. On Monday, February 22, 1858, Bernadette returned to the Grotto after school. Two policemen saw her and followed her, and so did the usual crowd. The policemen stood at respectful attention as she knelt down in her accustomed place. But as she arose, they sprang forward and asked her if she still insisted that she had seen a Beautiful Lady. "No, this time I saw nothing at all," she answered. She was allowed to go home, but she was taunted and threatened. People said mockingly that the Beautiful Lady was afraid of the police and had found some safer place to go. The Seventh Apparition - Tuesday, February 23, 1858: Approximately two hundred people were present at this apparition. When Bernadette's appearance was once more transformed, the men present removed their hats and fell to their knees. Bernadette appeared to be gravely serious and listening, and then joyful, and she would occasionally bow low. At the conclusion of the vision, which lasted an hour, Bernadette moved on her knees toward the rose bush and kissed the ground. When asked what the Lady had said, Bernadette replied that the Lady had entrusted her with three secrets, which she never revealed. The Eighth Apparition - Wednesday, February 24, 1858: During the eighth apparition, Bernadette turned and faced the crowd of more than four hundred

people, and three times she repeated, "penitence, penitence, penitence!"(t. b. c.)

Historia objawień w Lourdes.

«Jestem Niepokalnym Poczęciem» odpowiedziała Maryja na pytanie o to, kim jest. Dogmat ten ogłoszony został 4 lata wcześniej. Bernadeta nic o nim nie wiedziała. Niebieska Matka jest dla nas wzorem, kocha nas i o nas się troszczy. Milczące objawienia Matki Bożej przypominają nam: żyjemy pod spojrzeniem Maryi, najlepszej z matek. Możemy Ją kontemplować. Ona stale nam towarzyszy, ukazuje Siebie jako wzór do naśladowania. Przesuwała paciorki Różańca. Dla Bernadety było to przykładem i zachętą do modlitwy. Świadkowie twierdzili, że nawet sam sposób robienia przez Bernadetę znaku krzyża – «tak samo jak Pani» – nawracał grzeszników. Maryja patrzy na nas, Swe dzieci, patrzy spojrzeniem pełnym miłosierdzia, spojrzeniem Niebieskiej Mamy, towarzyszy każdemu Swojemu dziecku, we wszystkich częściach świata. Choć czujemy się słabi i chwiejni, stajemy się ofiarami otaczającego zła, nie wpadniemy w grzech, żyjąc pod niepokalanym spojrzeniem Niebieskiej Mamy i wpatrując się w Nią. Ona leczy zranienia, wylewa balsam na rany, karmi, wychowuje i prowadzi do świętości, tak jak doprowadziła do niej w krótkim czasie Bernadetę. Uśmiech Matki przypomina Jej dobroć. Maryja kocha nawet najbiedniejszych, którzy mogą być Jej wielką radością i pociechą. Maryja nie wymaga od nas rzeczy skomplikowanych. Wymagania Matki są proste: «Nie trzeba ich zapisywać» – wyjaśniła Bernadecie. Wypowiedziała je w słowach: modlitwa, pokuta, procesja, wybudowanie kaplicy i obmywanie się w źródle. Wymagania Maryi mogą realizować zarówno dzieci, jak i dorośli, wykształceni i ludzie prości, bogaci i najbiedniejsi. ... cdn
