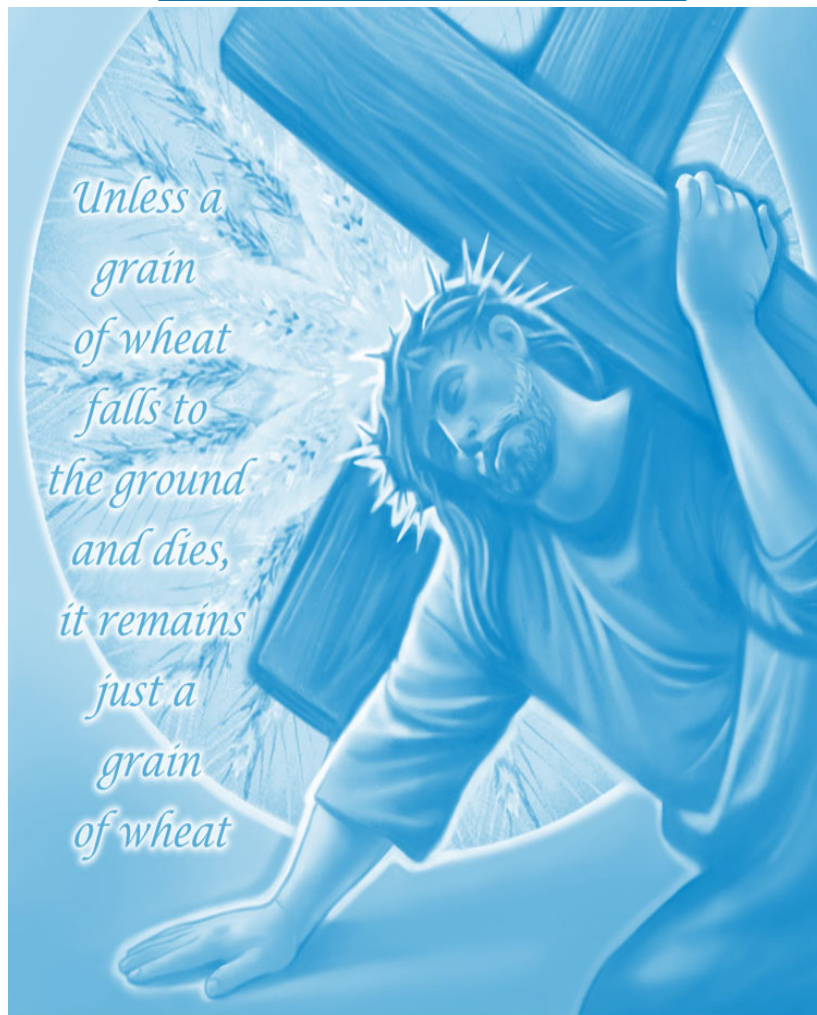

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SAINT BERNADETTE AND OUR LADY OF LOURDES

(Continued from Bulletin of March 15th) The Ninth Apparition - Thursday, February 25, 1858: During this apparition, the Beautiful Lady told Bernadette to, "drink from the fountain and bathe in it." Bernadette was puzzled; there had never been a fountain at Massabielle, or any kind of a natural spring. She began to scratch the loose gravel off the ground which encircled her. As she did so, she noticed that the ground beneath her was moist, and that a little pool was forming and bubbles were rising from it. She cupped her hands together and drank, and then washed her face. The next day, the pool was overflowing and water was dripping down over the rock. The following day, the trickle had become a real stream. Of course, it was immediately said - - and has been said by skeptics ever since -- that the spring was there all the time. The fact remains that Bernadette did find the spring as the result of a direct command. The Tenth Apparition - Saturday, February 27, 1858: On this occasion, the Beautiful Lady told Bernadette to "kiss the ground on behalf of sinners." She immediately did so, and the crowd followed her example. The Eleventh Apparition - Sunday, February 28, 1858: There were approximately two thousand spectators at the Grotto that morning. The Lady asked Bernadette to tell the clergy to build a chapel on the site of the Grotto. The Twelfth Apparition - Monday, March 1, 1858: During this apparition, the Lady commented to Bernadette that she was not using her own Rosary, which was an accurate statement. Bernadette had been asked by Pauline Sans to use Pauline's Rosary at the Grotto that day. The Thirteenth Apparition - Tuesday, March 2, 1858: Bernadette arrived at the Grotto early in the morning, prayed the Rosary in the presence of the Lady, who remained silent except for the Gloria's. Historia objawień w Lourdes.

Jesteśmy odpowiedzialni za zbawienie innych. Maryja prosi o modlitwę i pokutę za grzeszników, by się pojednali z Bogiem i osiągnęli niebo. Prosiła o przychodzenie do Niej w procesji, co wymagało od niejednego dużego wysiłku. Bóg nie zniewala człowieka: prosi go o współpracę. W Lourdes Maryja nie nakazała Bernadecie, że musi przychodzić do grotty, lecz zapytała ją, «czy byłaby tak dobra, by to uczynić.» Nie żądała odmawiania Różańca. Sama, dyskretnie, modląc się, zachęcała Swym przykładem. Po śmierci istnieje życie wieczne. Maryja obiecała Bernadecie szczęście wieczne i wskazała jej jako cel. Sama Maryja Wniebowzięta i ukazująca się w Swym uwielbionym, niepokalanym Ciele jest przykładem tej wiecznej szczęśliwości. Pomoc Maryi, dobrej Matki, jest bardzo skuteczna. Maryja pomaga nam wyzwolić się z różnych form zniewolenia. Leczy ciało i duszę. Symbolem tego działania Maryi jest źródło, poprzez które dokonały się liczne uzdrowienia i nawrócenia. Maryja – choć bez grzechu – nie gardzi nami, grzesznymi, lecz przychodzi, udziela pomocy. Matka Niebieska chce nas wyzwolić z jarzma wszelkiego zniewolenia. Maryja – zachęcając nas do obmywania się w źródle – chce nas wyzwolić z niewoli grzechu i nieuporządkowanych namiętności, szczególnie z nieczystości; z niewoli egoizmu i nienawiści, byśmy żyli w miłości; z niewoli systemów politycznych, zbudowanych na odrzucaniu Boga, na głoszonym i szerzonym ateizmie. Maryja chce nas wyzwolić z niewoli złych czasów, w których żyjemy, aby nas przygotować do wejścia w nowe, nadchodzące czasy. Musimy tylko dać się prowadzić Maryi, słuchać Jej rad, a zostaniemy uwolnieni i uświęceni. Do czego wzywa nas dzisiaj Maryja w Lourdes? Które z wezwań Matki Najświętszej(c.d.n.)
