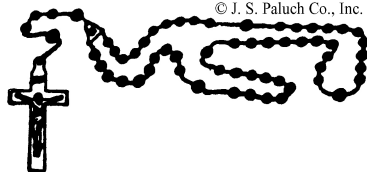

## **SAINT BERNADETTE AND OUR LADY OF LOURDES**

(Continued from Bulletin of April 19th). The Eighteenth Apparition - Friday, July 16, 1858: Bernadette seemed relieved that she was becoming less of a public figure. Several months had passed, and after receiving communion on the feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Bernadette felt an irresistible urge to return to the Grotto. Since the barricade was still in place, she and her aunt could not get as close to the sacred spot as they wanted, so they knelt in the grass, and the Beautiful Lady appeared to her one last time. Bernadette joined the order of the Sisters of Charity. Throughout her life she remained sickly, but attended patiently to her duties as infirmarian and sacristan. She died a holy death on April 16, 1879. She was 34 years old. Bernadette was buried on the convent grounds in Nevers, France. Her body was exhumed thirty years later on September 22, 1909, in the presence of two doctors, several appointed officials, and nuns from the local convent. When Bernadette's coffin was opened, there was no odor, and her body was completely untouched by the laws of nature. A second exhumation took place on April 3, 1919. The body of the then declared Venerable was found in the same state of preservation as ten years earlier, except that the face was slightly discolored, due to the washing it had undergone during the first exhumation. A worker in wax was entrusted with the task of coating the face of the Saint who had been dead forty years. The sacred relic (Bernadette's body) was placed in a coffin of gold and glass and can be viewed to this very day in the Chapel of Saint Bernadette at the motherhouse in Nevers, France. Note: In a book by Ruth Cranston, originally published by Doubleday in 1955, (I have an updated 1988 version), I am amazed by the testimonies and accounts of thousands who have claimed healing due to the miraculous

waters of the Grotto of Massabielle, in Lourdes France. Hundreds of cases have been reviewed by the Medical Bureau of Lourdes and deemed to be of a supernatural nature. The water from the Grotto still flows today, and people continue to attest to the healing powers of this God-given grace.

### **Historia objawień w Lourdes.**

Troszczyć się o oczyszczenie i poprawę świata. Maryja pragnie naszego oczyszczenia po to, abyśmy z kolei oczyszczali i uświęcali świat, zalewany błotem zła. Ileż dzieci Maryi doznaje codziennie skażenia błotem rozlewającym się coraz bardziej po świecie i prowadzącym niezmierną liczbę dusz ku śmierci! Matka Najświętsza jest Niepokalana, jest samą Czystością. W Niej musimy się chronić przed zalewem błota zła. Przed tym błotem zła i błędu możemy się też ocalić słuchając Papieża, który – całkowicie oddany Maryi – jest dla nas przykładem życia, jakiego pragnie Niepokalana Matka. Żyć w doskonałej czystości. Maryja wzywa nas, abyśmy się obmyli, bo chce doskonałej czystości naszego umysłu, serca i ciała, jak wyjaśniła nam przez ks. Gobbięgo w orędziu z 11 lutego 1977 roku. Być czystym w umyśle oznacza, że w myślach mamy szukać i wypełniać jedynie wolę Pana. Umysł nasz ma być w pełni otwarty na przyjęcie Bożego Światła i nie zaciemniony błędem. Mieć czyste serce to znaczy być prawdziwie zdolnym do miłości na d przyrodzonej i Bożej. Nieuporządkowane przywiązania do siebie i stworzeń rzucają cień na wewnętrzną czystość naszej miłości. Maryja pragnie czystości naszego ciała, bo pewnego dnia zmartwychwstanie ono – duchowe i oczyszczone – by cieszyć się światłem i życiem Bożym. (cdn..)
